## 2008 Jan 26/27 - GPS Challenge. Lake George, Beachport

Race day three of the KA Sail SA Summer of Speed was held at Lake George in very light winds. On Saturday we sailed in 10-13 knot south-westerlies and on Sunday in 10-13 knot westerlies. Each day sails were generally 7.5m with big boards and fins. The water level in the lake was guite low, so we had a long walk to the water's edge, then an equally long walk to deep water that would clear the 40cm+ fins. A dozen entrants competed with most of them camping out on the spit overnight enjoying the campfire and deteriorating conversation late into the evening. Onboard Surf was very generous in supplying sausages and beers as thanks for the performance of the Onboard-sponsored SA teams in the GPS Team Challenge. This kept everyone well fed over both nights and ensured we all had a drink in our hands - many thanks to Pete Boerma at Onboard. Thanks also to Steve Roberts for supplying his boat for rescue services, as we needed it this weekend for the recovery of two sailors, and thanks to Chris Reiffel for the use of his home-engineered bbq as it was put to good use.

February 16 or 17 is the final round of this series, and was originally scheduled for Boggy Lake. This event will be moved as there is now not enough water to safely compete at Boggy, so we might head back to the Murray Mouth. Stay tuned for the final location. This will also be the last chance to compete in this series, so for a chance to test your speeds and be in the running for a new KA Koncept sail, make sure you come along to the final round. This event will be followed by a bbq, major prize raffle and trophy presentation.
