INSURANCE

Thanks to all those members who have taken the time to renew their memberships. You can rest easy knowing that should you be unfortunate enough to be held liable through your negligence whilst windsurfing for injuring another person, other than another member, or be responsible for damaging their property then you are covered 24 hours a day by a \$10m public liability insurance policy. However, one word of caution - whilst the policy will respond to claims of any quantum, its real purpose is to provide indemnity to members for major claims - the million \$ plus type claim. Accordingly, claiming for every minor or insignificant incident has the distinct potential of blowing future premium costs out of the realms of affordability or even worse, creating a situation whereby the policy is not able to be renewed this more than ever before is a very real risk given to-day's volatile public liability insurance environment. A claim excess of \$1000 applies and is payable by the claimant and is intended to discourage trivial claims being made thereby keeping premium costs to an absolute minimum.

Please be aware that the policy is a public liability policy and does not cover you for injuries you cause to yourself or for damage you do to your own property whilst you are windsurfing. In addition, although a public liability policy, it has a member to member exclusion which means that you are not covered if you are liable for injuries to another member or for damage caused by you to their property whilst you are windsurfing.

So if you haven't renewed yet now is the time for you to complete the membership renewal form included in the Newsletter, attach your cheque for \$40.00 made out to "Windsurfing SA" and post it off to PO Box 7022, Hutt Street, Adelaide 5000 without delay. Your help in this regard will be greatly appreciated. Go on, do it now!!

Also seperate to the above question John, can one just pay the \$40 Windsurfiing SA annual fee and be covered for 3rd party liability without having to join a club? Is joining a club necessary....?

Yes, you can join Windsurfing SA for \$40 without joining a Club.

In the past, we have had Clubs that were considered as a "Division of Windsurfing SA". That Club would be considered a committee organising events at a particular location. The old Murray Bridge sailboard club ran under this system.

All Club members will have to be financial Windsurfing SA members, and only Financial Windsurfing SA members would be able to run events. Only financial members would be eligible to participate in events - an Insurance requirement. Public Come'n'Try days would be the exception, in that the public would not have to be a Club Member, but the organisers must. Volunteers aiding the organisers are usually covered under the policy.

So it's up to you if you want to go the whole hog and have your own constitution, committee structure, etc. or just keep it simple as has been done in the past.

Currently, the only SA Club mentioned on the policy is "Windsurfing SA Inc."

SELECTION/NOMINATION GUIDELINES

2003 ISAF Youth Sailing World Championships

The Australian Yachting Federation (AYF) has recently announced its guidelines to be used for the nomination and selection of the Australian Team to sail at the 2003 ISAF Youth sailing World Championships in Portugal in July, 2003. For the boards, the two regattas involved are the 2003 Australian Youth Championships and the 2003 Mistral Australian Championships.

To be eligible for nomination and selection competitors must:

- Be a national of Australia at the time that the nomination is made
- Be a current member of a yacht/sailing club affiliated with a State or Territory Yachting Association
- Be a current AYF Youth or Silver Member
- Not attain their 19th birthday by the 31st December 2003
- Comply with the RRS Appendix 2 ISAF Eligibility Code

A point score based on the two nomination regattas will be used to determine the competitors nominated for selection.
